These tips from Family Tree Magazine, Sept. 2007, pg 18-19:

This is something I tend to forget and wanted to pass it on to our members.

Whenever you are on a site that has many databases to search through with one general search window remember that searching each database separately will always give you better results. Sometimes there are search fields and options that are not included with the general search window. AND...database searches will only show your ancestor's information if the information you are searching on is the same as you have entered. Try a search with all the information you know (birth, birth-place death, death-place, spouse name, etc.). If no results turn up, try eliminating an item and search again. Keep eliminating or switching combination of items (name, birth-date and place OR name and spouse). Also read the search instructions as they often include tips and tricks that you may not think of using. I know you are thinking reading the instructions on the site is a waste of your valuable time...trust me and just do it.

WEBSITES WORTH CHECKING:

Some of these will be repeats but if you haven't tried them recently, it is time!

www.familysearch.org With the indexing project going on by all those dedicated volunteers this is sure to be one to check regularly.

<http://www.co.napa.ca.us/library/> Through our own city/county library we have access to an Amazing collection HeritageQuest Online. You will need a library card. When on the site, choose the research tab and scroll down to Literature, Biography and Genealogy where you will see more than just HeritageQuest. You will need to enter some information when you choose the database to search to prove you are a Napa Library Card holder.

www.usgenweb.org I am sure you have seen this but keep checking it over and over as it changes often. It includes resources at the various state and county levels including genealogical and historical societies.

www.archives.gov This is the National Archives site that is somewhat complex but is adding information continually with the help of many volunteers.

And, of course is our subscription to www.ancestry.com This is a \$\$ subscription that we have in our library. New stuff all the time!! www.rootsworld.com is part of the Ancestry.com family but is free to use!

The following symbols on tombstones represent these meanings:

Flowers and bouquets in general represent sorrow and the fragility of life. Varieties have more specific interpretations. Buds for a life cut short, full rose for prime of life or a severed stem for a life cut short.

Particular flowers usually follow the Victorian "language of flowers" symbolism. Examples include Bellflower - constancy and gratitude

Calla lily - majestic beauty and marriage

Daisy - innocence, often on a child's grave

Evening primrose - eternal love, memory, youth, hope and sadness

Garland or wreath - victory in death

Iris - sorrow

Lily, lily of the valley or tulip - innocence, resurrection

Lotus - resurrection, perfect beauty, spiritual revelation

Morning glory - beginning of life

Pansy - remembrance, mediation

Poppy - eternal sleep

Rose - purity, love

Thistle - Scottish descent or remembrance

Violet - humility

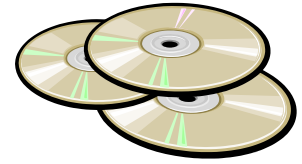

GAS TRIP TO SUTRO AND NATIONAL ARCHIVES

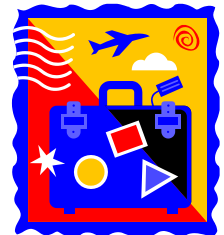
